Hmm.

This part of the docs

IDL Programmer's Guides - Defining and Using Constants - Integer Constants

implies that U and US are identical.

OTOH, the table in the DEFINT section implies that the constant 42U does not include a type specifier.

Huh?

There may be a good reason for this syntactical subtlety (aka "a really obscure feature"), but ITTVIS REALLY needs to make this clearer in the docs.
