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Hi,

I am having trouble with my IDL_PATH defined in my .bashrc.

Here is how it is defined:

```
IDL_PATH="+${my_path}/idl:/home/jim/lib/IDL/:<IDL_DEFAULT >/home/bob/
routines/:"
```

```
export IDL_PATH
```

Then it points to 3 directories (my IDL, jim's IDL and bob routines'). Note that "my path" is correctly defined before because wherever i am, i can call routines stored here.

The thing is that when i add a new routine in \${my_path}/idl/ and i want to call it from another directory, i get the message: "Attempt to call undefined procedure/function" whereas it is well located in {my_path}/idl/....

Does anyone know what goes wrong?
