Can you launch the help app via any combination of command line calls? If so, write a procedure that does this and tell users to run the procedure rather than the "?" command.

I have the following alias to launch the IDL Helper.app from the unix (not IDL) command line. It does not bring up help for a specific procedure, but the search field is highlighted so I just type a few characters, hit enter, and then I'm viewing the procedure. Note also that "doc library" might be a good temporary substitute to get help for a specific procedure.

alias idlhelp='/Users/mankoff/local/itt/idl64/bin/bin.darwin.i386/ idl assistant.app/Contents/MacOS/idl assistant -server -profile /Users/ mankoff/local/itt/idl64/help/online_help/idl.adp &'
