I don't know if this would help, but a reasonable facsimile can be produced by creating a large set of 'standard results' save to file, and serving them from a webpage.

I've done that in the past, with about 5 different input variables, all of which

could have many (up to 12) possible variables. For instance, global wavenumber

from -6 to 6, periods ranging from 3hr, 6hr, 8hr, 12hr, 24 hr, 48 hr, etc.
