Does anyone know how to manipulate the cursor under the mac version of IDL? When I try to set the cursor\_image keyword in a device call I get an error 'Keyword CURSOR\_IMAGE not allowed in call to: DEVICE'.

I have done this successfully under UNIX IDL, so what gives? None of the documentation suggests this might be a problem.

I have some other Mac IDL specific questions: xloadct does not work properly on my mac. Changing the color table does not update the currently displayed graphics. Why?

I reinstalled IDL to try to fix the above problem. Now when I type '?' at the prompt, IDL fails to open the onlline help application. I get no error and this worked fine before. Anybody got any ideas?
