Though I have abandoned its use to edit IDL code years ago (in favor of IDL's editors, even in pre-Eclipse times, or, in their absence, Emacs), vi always highlighted IDL syntax for me, out of the box.

Looking around, the IDL-related files I could find come in the package vim-common-7.2.245-3.fc12.x86_64:

/usr/share/vim/vim72/indent/idlang.vim

/usr/share/vim/vim72/syntax/idlang.vim

There are other files that mention idl in the name, but they refer to the Interface Description Language.
