- > then give them to write_csv, such as

- > But write_csv encapsulates strings in quotes, which is probably
- > undesirable if your data were not strings.
- > So it is probably better to use plain old printf with the format you
- > want plus the commas to separate the fields.

Thanks, pp. I guess I'll go with printf. Another disadvantage of write_csv is that it limits the number of output columns to 8.
