How are they different?

You have changed the size and dimension of your array (by averaging over the first dimension) so writefits.pro automatically changes the NAXIS and NAXISi keywords, which must match the size and dimensions of the stored array. Otherwise, the FITS header should not be changed by your script. --Wayne
