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Hi IDL,

Just a note that my KML library now supports placing vertical curtains of data in Google Earth. Example here:

This isn't a feature supported by Google Earth or KML, but if you make buildings very thin you can place them wherever you like.

I have some confidence in the general KML API implementation I've done, but for this vertical data... I've tested it a bit with my data for my purposes, but I'm not certain of the implementation. If you use it, please let me know if you come across any bugs, or if a different interface makes more sense to you.
