Thanks a lot for the constructive comments! I was using SCOPE\_VARFETCH simply to export the variables to the main level... but I'm now convinced that this is not a good practice. One of the suggestions I got was to include parameters in my procedure, define the variables within the procedure, and then call it specifying the parameters similarly on the command line. Something like this:

```
pro xxx, a=a, b=b, c=c
```

This would add the variables of interest (a, b, and c) in main just like SCOPE\_VARFETCH does. I guess that's the usual way of doing this and I would probably not end in jail =)... so, here we go.
