Thanks a lot for the advice. It did the trick! I used envi_write_envi_file to write a file to memory and then envi_output_to_external_format to retrieve that file and write it to to an ASCII file. In the call I used the new file's id and added the "dims" and "pos" keywords which I had forgotten to include too. I just have to resize the arrays and do a couple of more things to get it all right, but I am on my way now.
