How are they different? > > > You have changed the size and dimension of your array (by averaging > over the first dimension) so writefits.pro automatically changes the > NAXIS and NAXISi keywords, which must match the size and dimensions of > the stored array. Otherwise, the FITS header should not be changed > by your script. --Wayne
