> currently do).

Assume you have a floating license, if you know the name of the  
license server and port(1700 is the default), you can add the  
following to the .cshrc file:

```
setenv IDL_LMGRD_LICENSE_FILE 1700@hostname
```

where hostname is the name of your license server.
