>> "RESTORE" command does not recognize them:
>> IDL> save, a, filename='test.sav'
>> IDL> exit
>> \$ gzip test.sav
>> \$ idl
>> IDL> restore, 'test.sav.gz'
>> % RESTORE: Not a valid save file: test.sav.gz
>
>> This trick worked for binary files and OPEN command.

>> done, creating save files which can be directly opened from inside
