Yes, I was too careless last night. In reading manuals;-(and in performing tests. This morning I put a file into the folder, which is the target of a symbolic link. Corresponding to the manual file_search does not see this file (in the symbolic link). It does not find the file in both syntaxes, the recursive and the standard one. So the results on Linux and on Windows are the same. At least for the recursive search.

By the way cygwin does not to create real symbolic links. It simulates them by using Windows-shortcuts.
