The preview is a 2D plot with each point in x,y as a square colored by its z value (as `iplot` would make), with a contour plot over it (as `icontour` would make). Depending on how densely distributed your points are, this may look more like a continuous image (as `image` would make). You just need to use tool that gives you the kind of visualization you want.
