The preview is a 2D plot with each point in x,y as a square colored by its z value (as iplot would make), with a contour plot over it (as icontour would make). Depending on how densely distributed your points are, this may look more like a continuous image (as image would make). You just need to use tool that gives you the kind of visualization you want.
