Hello all,

is there any hint how I might have switched off the functionality of !p.multi? I have a quite long display and plotting routine calling several routines like tvim or skewt, which works well if called first in an IDL session. If I call this routine a second time, the setting of the !p.multi parameter (I use !p.multi=[0,2,2]) does not change the size of the plot and its position. So the plots and images are plotted one over the other, while !p.multi is behaving well.

This happens both on a 'x' - device and on a postscript plot.
