I have seen it happen when an X program was called from the ssh session. A ctrl-c ends the hung logout. If all else fails, you can kill the ssh process.

I have had screen sessions running for months, with dozens of connection cycles. When I am shutting down my laptop I usually do not even bother to detach and exit the ssh. On reconnect, screen can be given the -d switch, to detach the screen from the previous terminal, if it is still attached. Which is another use of screen, to keep the session in the event of a lost network connection.

On a different point, have you checked that your original problem was not due to the input? That is, would

nohup nice /opt/rsi/idl/bin/idl batch_script >& log &

work?
