> machine. If I load up XLOADCT, the color table gets refreshed neither
> on the color band on the top, nor on the image I want to change the
> color table for. This even happens in the demo! On our Windows NT
> 4.0 machine on the other hand, XLOADCT behaves perfectly normally.

Dear Imad

on my Windows95 machine XLOADCT works fine. However, on another machine running Windows 3.11, I experienced a similar problem with IDL 4.0.1: plots simply didn't show up. It turned out that the graphics driver was configured to 16 instead of 256 colors. Thus you might check the Windows95 graphics setup (number of colors and graphics adapter driver).
