- > % Attempt to call undefined procedure/function: 'GNSS\_GET\_UTC\_DATE'.
- > % Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$

- > I had added the directory of the function gnss\_get\_utc\_date.pro into
- > the !PATH variable by the command

> !Path = !Path + ':<path to the function>'

- > and as you can see, IDL does find this function and happily compiles
- > it, then turns around and says it can't be found?? Can anyone suggest
- > what might be going wrong here?

You could get this kind of error if you wrote the module as a function and tried to call it as a procedure, or visa versa.
