As I understand it, routine_info(/system) only shows those that are not implemented in IDL. I did notice that many init functions show up: even though, say, IDLFFXMLDOMDOCUMENT() does not appear, its actual function, IDLFFXMLDOMDOCUMENT::INIT, does. And init functions I defined in DLMs also show up. So the overload does not show, but the init functions that are overloaded do. List's init does not show because it is written in IDL.
