I suppose it is to make the classes still possible to compile in earlier versions of IDL. Yes, the overloading would not be usable with those versions, but the rest of the class could still be used (provided none of the new syntax is used in the code that will get used). This way, one just needs to make a dummy IDL_Object class to inherit from, as Michael Galloy suggests.

So it makes easier the transition period (which can be awfully long, due to the unresponsiveness of those sysadmins that I have met; I have not been as lucky as Paul).

> BTW, does IDL 8.0 have the ability to create user defined operators?

I think only those predefined operators can be used.
