I think, this question has to be answered by the ITTVIS folks.

In the case, you are sure that a file with the name filename is existing, you could do the following check:

if n\_elements(file\_search(filename)) ge 2 then \$ message, 'Non-unique file specification...'

So you can stop program execution by issuing an error message, instead of deleting or renaming wrong files.

Another way could be to check a whole directory for critical file parallelisms:

a=file\_search('\*')
if n\_elements(uniq(a,sort(a))) ne n\_elements(a) then \$
 message,'Ambiguous file access...'
