For example, say I have: IDL> a = indgen(2,10) & b = indgen(2,6) which are placeholders for arrays given by array\_indices. I want to get c as a (2,16) array... and currently I'm doing IDL> c = transpose([[transpose(a)],[transpose(b)]])
