> If you want to spawn things, you just assemble a command (IDL or not)

> into a string, and give that to spawn.

>

> If it is to run a savefile:

>

> spawn,'idl -rt=whatever.sav'

>

> You may or not want to capture the output of the command, with spawn's

> arguments.

>

> But it does not have to be a savefile. You could do

>

> spawn,'idl -e "print,acos(-1d0)"'

>

> Or run a batch file:

>

> spawn,'idl something.pro'
