Not that I've found yet. I made one yesterday with LAYOUT and MARGIN, which is now in sensible, normalized units instead of character widths. Since MARGIN is relative to the plot window defined by LAYOUT, I found using that combo much easier than defining everything from scratch using POSITION. I rarely got good results with !P.MULTI/MARGIN in direct graphics, so that's an improvement.

I wish they would have expanded TICKLAYOUT to simply suppress labels but keep ticks, though. I still had to use blank TICKNAME arrays to get that to work properly.
