Hi all,

I'm using the new plot object/feature of IDL 8.0 and noticed a problem when using 2 monitors. The IDL workbench is sitting on the right display and the application I wrote starts on the left (because it's really xoffset 0). Ok, well my application brings to life at some point an object plot. I want this plot to show up just on the right of my GUI. I retrieve the offset and xsize of that gui and pass it to the location keywords of plot:

```
my_plot = plot([0,1], nodata=1, location=[xoff, yoff])
```

but the problem is that for my\_plot, the offset 0 is on the left of the right screen. How can I force it to be the real 0 offset.
