> my code looks like this. I show you PDF output, but I
> often use PNG, JPEG, or TIFF, depending on what I'm
> doing and where I want to view the output. Just set
> the appropriate keyword. ImageMagick does the conversion
> from PostScript to any of these other formats.
>
> IDL> PS_Start
> IDL> My_Graphic_Program
> IDL> PS_End, /PDF

You are right. No PDF files. I've been creating PNG files and importing those at high resolution (600 dpi).
