Do you get the same if you start the Workbench from the command line (idlde) or from some icon/menu?

Maybe PATH is being set to include ImageMagick's directory in a .cshrc file? The error above indicates that IDL is spawning bash.

Anyway, you could spawn 'echo \$PATH', to find out how it differs from the PATH in your terminal, it might give clues to where the difference originates.
