Also, I am finishing writing a class to provide in the new graphics functionality like IDLAstro's multiplot does for direct graphics. It is more flexible than multiplot, allowing to have lines/columns of different heights/widths, and providing synchronization of axes properties. It will be out probably sometime this week.
