Below is how I go about obtaining the value of the first child.

doc = OBJ_NEW('IDLffXMLDOMDocument', FILENAME=filename)
elementValue = (((doc->GetFirstChild()-> $
  GetElementsByTagName(elementName))->item(0))-> $
  GetFirstChild()->GetNodeValue()
```
