I agree layout is better, for those reasons, and most significantly, for not being a global variable. Everything that determines how a plot will be in Graphics is contained in them, and set through their methods. The frequent use of global variables (in particular those that are not affected by .reset) is one of the most important reasons I avoid DG.
