The equivalent of !P.MULTI is to use the LAYOUT and CURRENT keywords,  
but you do have to manage the current drawing pane manually, as David  
illustrated here

> You want to use the LAYOUT keyword in conjunction with  
> the CURRENT keyword.  
> IDL> p = plot(loaddata(17), layout=[2,2,1])  
> IDL> p = plot(loaddata(17), layout=[2,2,2], /current)  
> IDL> p = plot(loaddata(17), layout=[2,2,3], /current)  
> IDL> p = plot(loaddata(17), layout=[2,2,4], /current)
