If you want to prevent anyone from restoring write permissions on the file and then modifying it, you have to change the owner of the file and then give only read permission to other users. As far as I know, this owner change can only be done by the super user/system administrator. It is how all the system files are protected against modification by regular users. If you also want to prevent deletion of the file, its containing directory must also be owned by a different user.
