Yes, and several people have suggested a CATCH error handler, which to almost everyone responding here would seem to be *exactly* what you want to use. So, what is the problem?

Is the problem that the "message" is an informational message and not really an error?

We really need more details I guess, if we are going to help in any sensible way. It doesn't help us to know something "didn't work." That's almost always an excuse for pilot error. :-)
