Hey, I'm trying to structure my IDL program into several event handlers, e.g. one procedure that opens a file, one that save data etc. To do this I have used EVENT_PRO like this:

PRO MotionControl

file_menu = WIDGET_BUTTON(bar, VALUE='File', /MENU)
file_btn1 = WIDGET_BUTTON(file_menu, VALUE='Open dataset',
UVALUE='OpenDat', EVENT_PRO = 'OpenData')
file_btn2 = WIDGET_BUTTON(file_menu, VALUE='Save dataset',
UVALUE='SaveDat', EVENT_PRO = 'SaveData')
```

XMANAGER, 'MotionControl', tlb
```

In this way I have one event handler that is called MotionControl_event that takes care of all the events not handled by specified EVENT_PRO. I don't know if this is a really bad way of structuring my code, even though it does work. Can somebody give me some tips?
