I think, the answer depends on the OS and on the browser. For Windows I can say the following: I can start the IDL 8 Help with Firefox, which is not my default browser, by the following Command from the IDL 8 Workbench or Console:

spawn,"C:\Program Files\Mozilla Firefox\firefox.exe" '+ \$ 'file:///"'+!dir+'/help/online_help/IDL/idl.html"',/noshell,/nowait
