- > initial setup similar to IDL's PREF SET, PREF GET, etc. That would
- > allow the user to decide what they really want as defaults if different
- > than what you provide. There could even be a default per device.

There are some good suggestions here, Ben, but I think I am content to leave these traditional graphics commands alone to act, well, traditionally. I'll save these ideas for my new simple, *function* graphics system that I'll be introducing with the book I'm writing next.
