- > But the final object text is always using Helvetica.
- > I also tried, Lucida, Utopia, Palladio, etc. It seems that my computer
- > has these fonts because I listed them:
- > DEVICE, GET_FONTNAMES=fnames, SET_FONT='*'

> Mmmh! What am I missing?

To use your true-type font in object graphics, I *believe* you have to add its name to the ttfont.map file in the IDL_DIR/resource/fonts/tt directory. It's been a while since I did this, but you can read about it in the middle of this article:
