- > use something like:

> plot,y,position=[1000,1000,6000,6000],/device

Yikes! Don't do something like this. Set *either* the !P.MULTI system variable *OR* position each plot with the POSITION keyword, but *don't* do BOTH. You will get some very confusing results if you do.

And by the way, if you want portable code, I wouldn't be doing this in DEVICE coordiates. I'd do it in NORMAL coordiates. Then you don't have to write special code for PostScript and for your display.
