The execution is done with a Perl wrapper that writes a namelist with options for the IDL code.

my \$result=exec("/usr/local/bin/idl -quiet -queue -rt=\'\$idl_executable \' -args \'\$namelist_file\' 2>&1");

I was hoping that the "2>&1" would push the IDL output to STDOUT, but no such luck.

I can't even lay odds as to whether this is a Perl thing or an IDL thing...
