I'm running IDL 7.1 on Linux (KDE version: 3.5.4-25.el5\_4.1 Red Hat) and I cannot even open a single \*.jpg file. When I try to open a single image file I'm getting an error: "Fatal error: IDL has encountered a fatal error and will now exit.". I have no idea what to do. Please be tolerant because I'm new to Linux and IDL so it's quite challenging for me. Thanks for your help in advance.

PS. I've already found this topic https://groups.google.com/d/topic/comp.lang.idl-pvwave/eWjc0 OUoVvw/discussion. Creating new workspace didn't help. I don't know how to change the environment variable but I put "MALLOC\_CHECK\_=0" into a shell, then ran IDL but I still receiving this error :(
