> I have a question though - probably me being dim - but which command do I use to display an image in one of your new resizable windows? The equivalent of TVSCL, image?

You can use:

TVImage, image, ..., /Scale

Or,

TVScale, image, ...

TVScale is just a simple wrapper that calls TVImage with the SCALE keyword set.

This reminds me, though, that I haven't added a WINDOW keyword to TVImage to send it directly to an FSC_Window application. I'll do that now. At the moment, you will have to add this to FSC_Window like this:

FSC_Window, 'TVImage', image, /Scale, /ADDCMD
