I have written simple test programs and the problem looks like this: > > files Contains: .compile imhfiles > compt1.pro [works!] > Is a 1-line file with no blanks or (cr) at end of line. > compt2.pro [works!] Contains: .compile imhfiles Is a 1-line file with 1 blank and no (cr) at end of line. compt3.pro [not work!?] Contains: .compile imhfiles > Is a 2-line file with 1 blank and one (cr) at the end of the first line, and nothing on the second line. > This simple line of code does not work within the batch file I am working on.

I can't get this to break on my Mac. Are you invoking the batch file with the @ sign?
