> Here is the simple procedure "pseudo_to_true", which I neglected to post
> along with the write_mpeg procedure:

```
...  
> image24(0,*,*) = red(image8(*,*))  
> image24(1,*,*) = green(image8(*,*))  
> image24(2,*,*) = blue(image8(*,*))
```

Try the following simple change and see if it speeds things up a bit:

```
image24(0,0,0) = red(image8)  
image24(1,0,0) = green(image8)  
image24(2,0,0) = blue(image8)
```

Do a timing test in a loop and compare the two variations.

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
