IDL> xwin = !D.WINDOW

XWIN LONG = 44

 λ VVIN LONG = 44

IDL> wshow, xwin

So what are the alternatives? Currently I am doing this:

IDL> img = Transpose(tvrd(/TRUE), [1,2,0])
IDL> WDELETE, xwin
IDL> cgDisplay, /FREE, XSIZE=500, YSIZE=500
IDL> cgImage, img

But is there a better solution?
