- > Do you have some way of knowing which month corresponds to which
- > data? Like a month array or something? What are your data types?
- > You're going to want to use WHERE().

That's a good idea; since there are no month labels on the data in the file (just the numbers), I can just create a month array, and where month[i] is DEC, JAN, or FEB I could have it grab temp[i] from my data array. That way I'd get a new array with just the temps from those three months. I'll give that a try.
