Mirko Vukovic wrote:

- > I want to overplot lines over an image. The way I'd like it is to OR
- > it, in the sense that the line is dark over light parts and light over
- > dark parts. Thought that I've seen that written or mentioned somewhere,
- > but cannot find anything in the manual.

You have to change the graphics mode to XOR mode, draw stuff, and then restore the old graphics mode:

```
wset, my_window
color = !d.table size - 1
device, get_graphics = oldg, set_graphics = 6
plots, [x1,x2], [y1,y2], /noclip, /device, color = color
device, set_graphics = oldg
```

You can later "erase" the line by doing the same commands again.

Hope this helps.
