The next evolution of the GRAFFER data plotting tool, version 1.05, is now available.

This incorporates many improvements from the previous version (1.04).

Of these the most significant are probably:

- *> A compact layout is now available for small screens.
- *> There is a routine GRAFF_ADD which allows you to add a dataset to a GRAFFER file as a call from your IDL program.
- *> Polar plots can now be handled.
